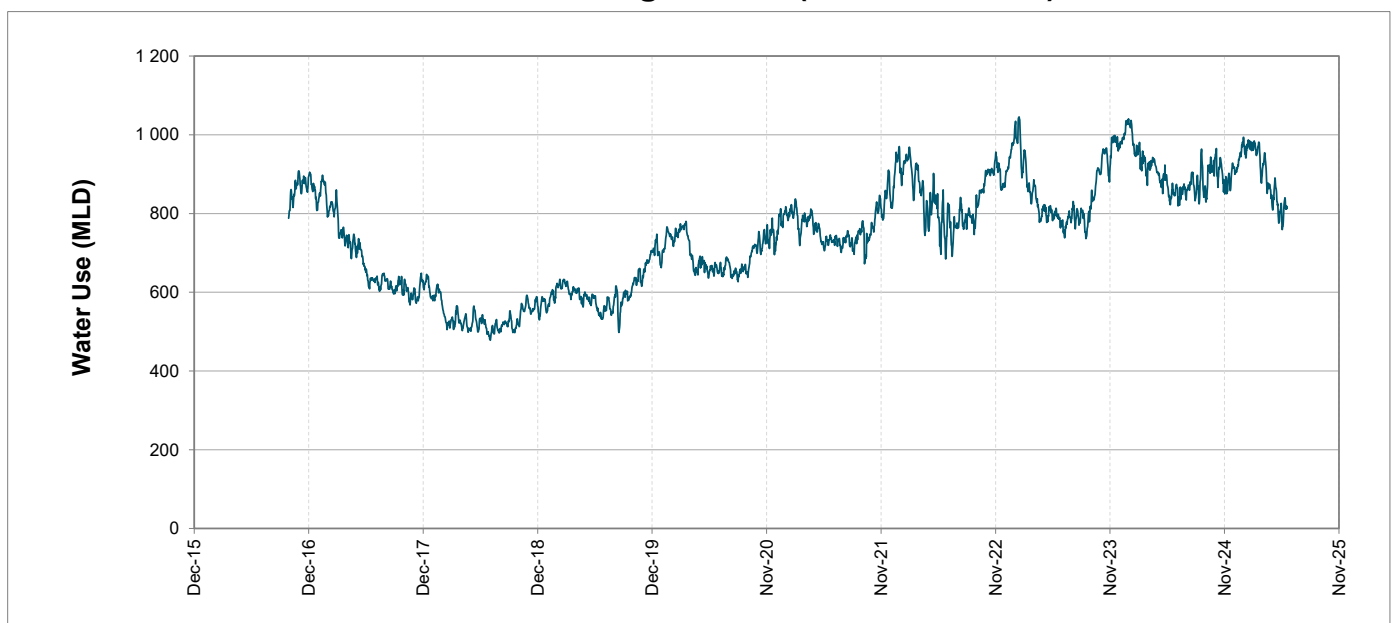

MLD means million litres per day

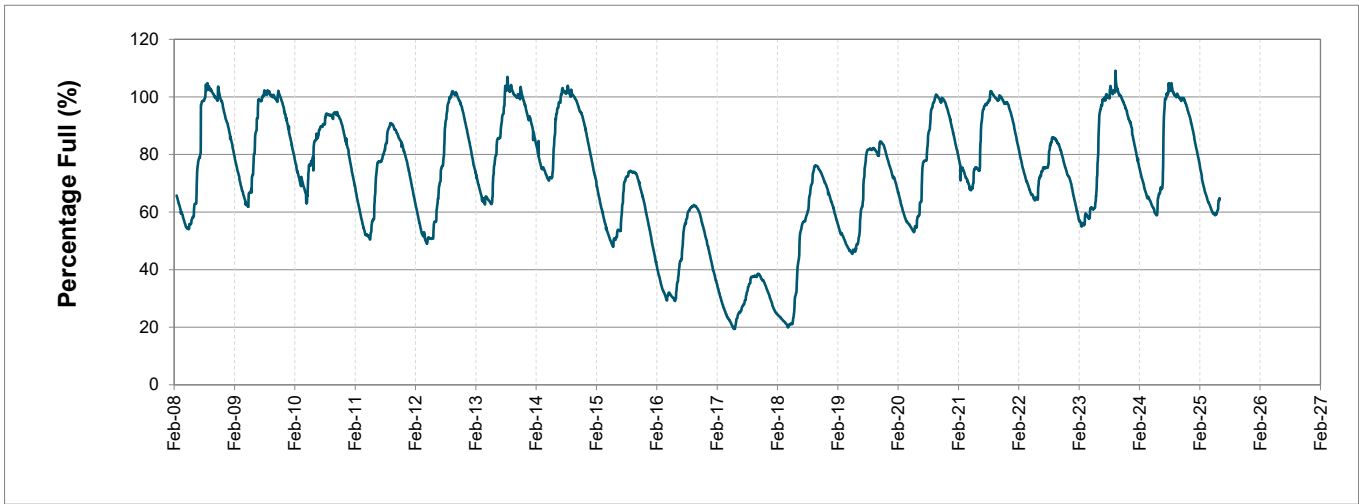

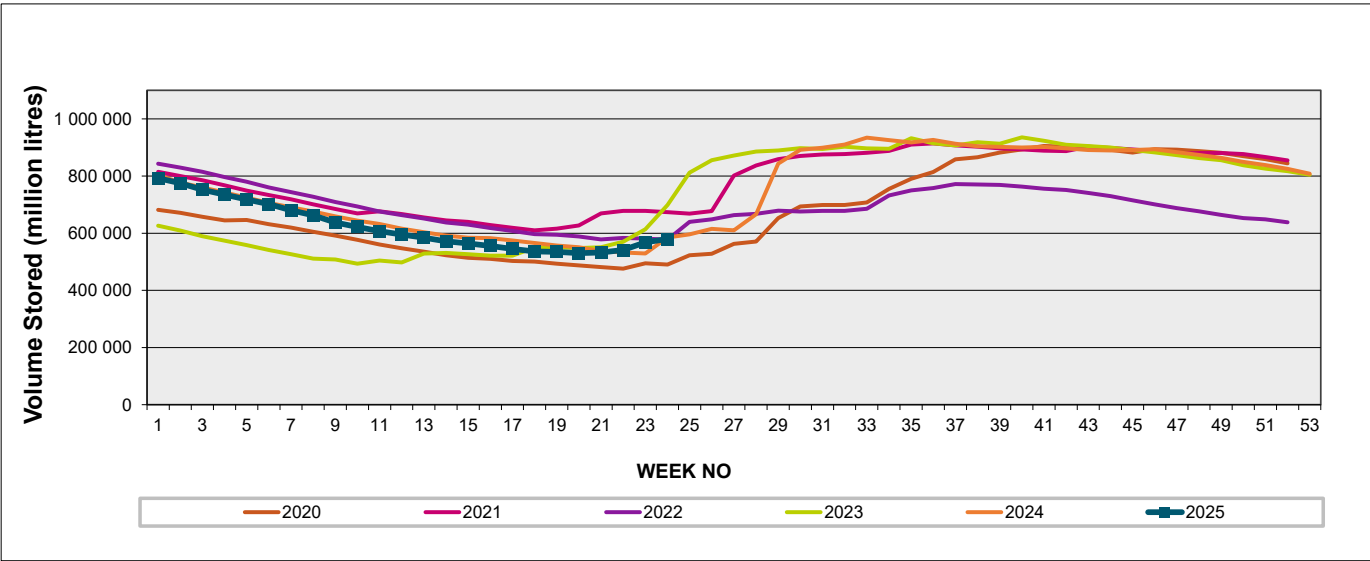

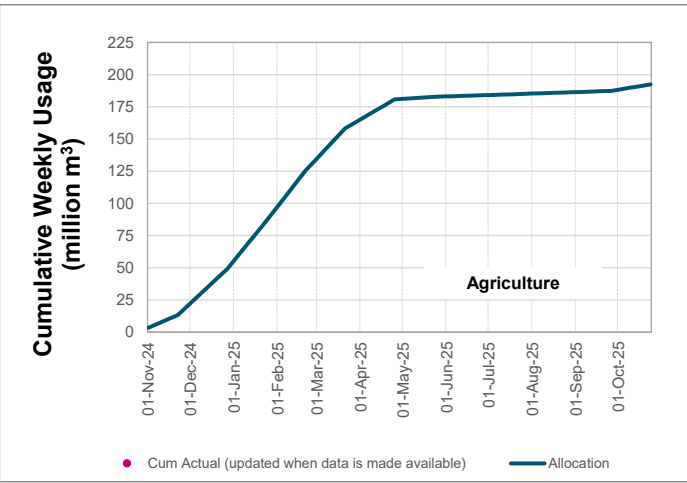
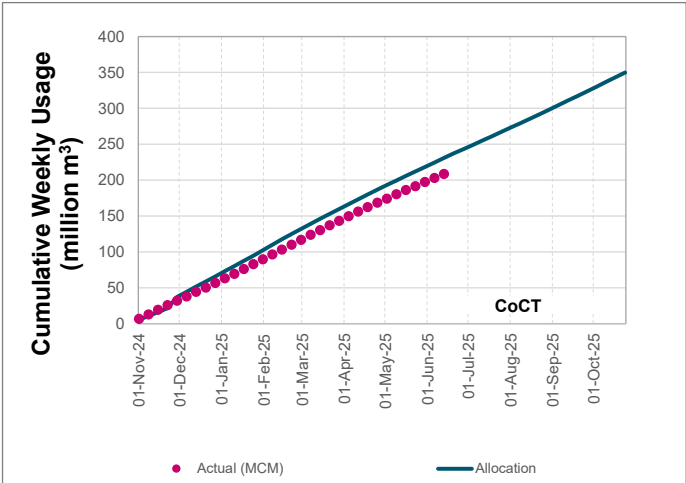
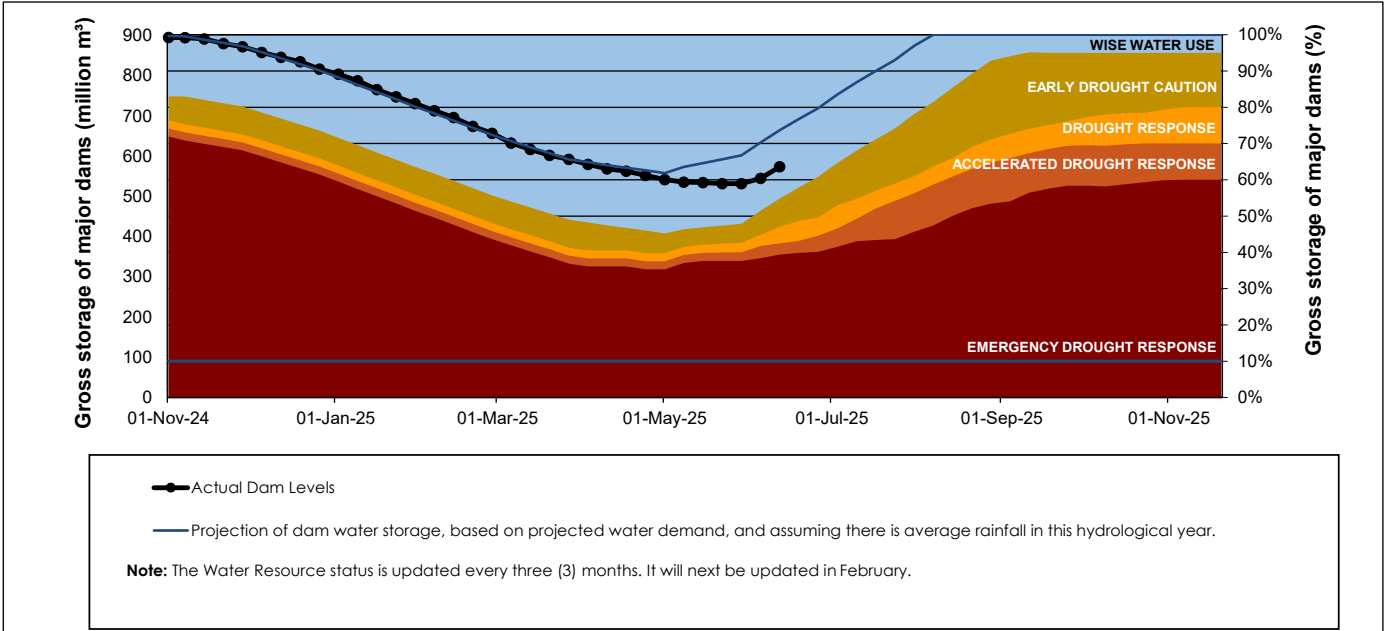
WCWSS Storage Record (2008 - Present)

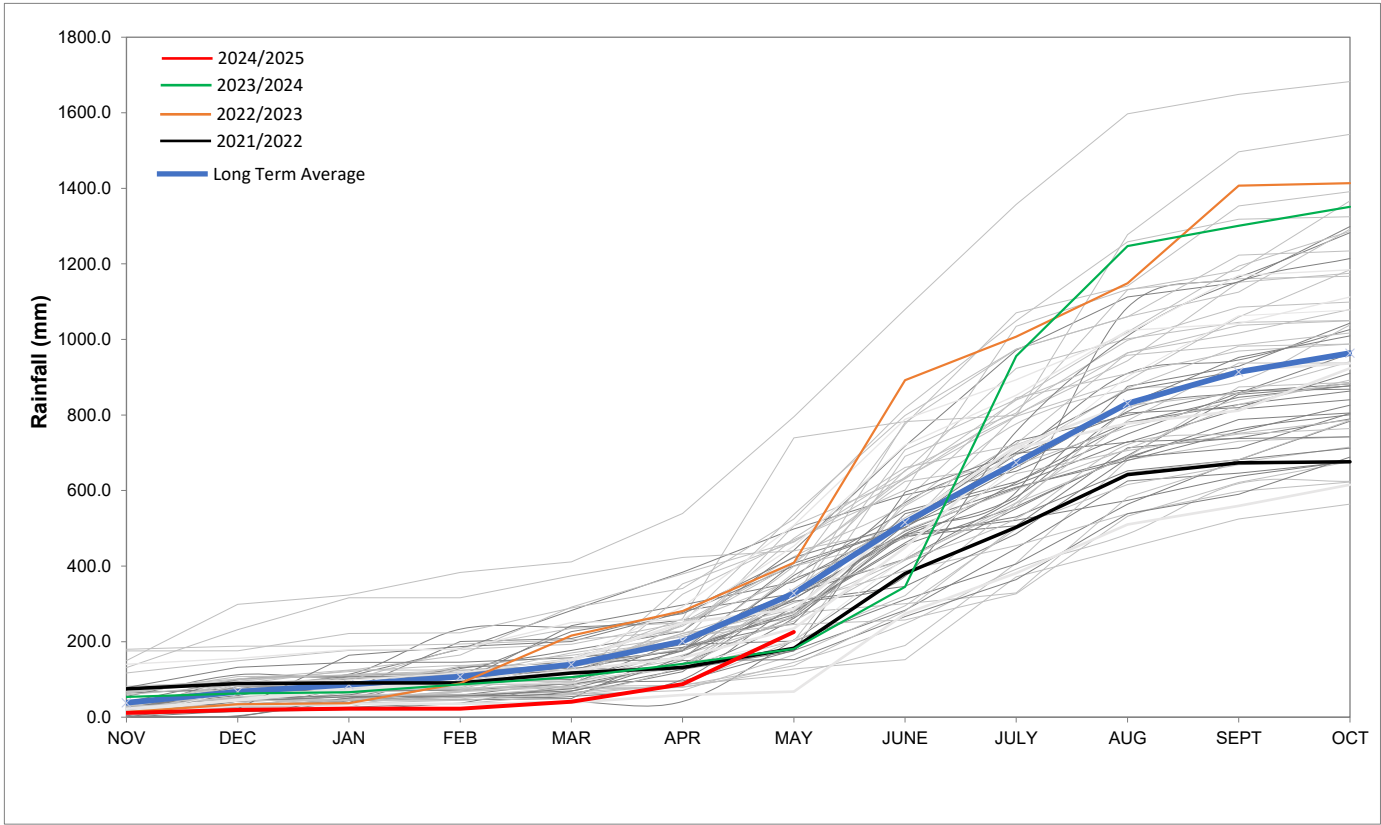
